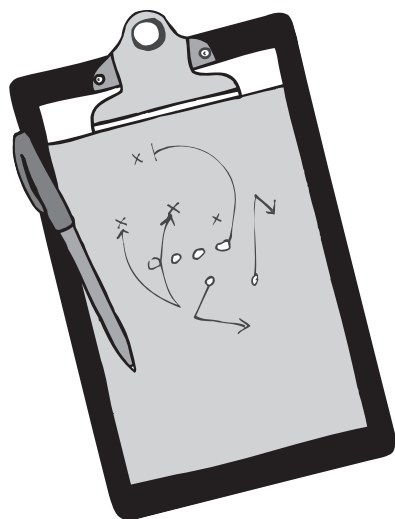


Sports education workshop



Coaching processes and communication skills – Sydney 2008

Communication and teaching skills are essential requirements for any sports coach or official. This interactive seminar will identify the issues that lead to communication problems and explore means of overcoming them and how to better resolve conflict situations.

This seminar will also examine the different learning styles and how a coach can use this information to improve the way they teach skills to their athletes or players.

Privacy statement

The information will be provided to instructors of the program and their supervisors, where necessary, and you consent to this disclosure. If you have been asked for information regarding Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander descent and cultural background, this information is voluntary and is being compiled for statistical purposes only. Any information provided by you will be stored on a database that will only be accessed by authorised personnel and is subject to privacy restrictions. The information will only be used for the purpose for which it was collected. Any information provided by you to the department can be accessed by you during standard office hours and updated by writing to us or by contacting us on 13 13 02.

Refunds and cancellations

Requests for refunds must be made within seven (7) working days prior to the commencement of the program in which you are enrolled. All requests must be made in writing. All refunds are subject to an administration fee of 20 per cent of the total program fee. Refunds will not be given for partial attendance, nor will make up lessons be provided. Refunds will be paid at the completion of the program. NSW Sport and Recreation reserves the right to cancel any program/s. Every effort will be made to give reasonable notice to those who have enrolled when a program is cancelled. Those enrolled will be given a full refund.
