OVERVIEW

CRITERIA

The applicant must be an accredited fencing coach with the Australian Fencing Federation as well as a currently affiliated coach member of NSWFA. Successful applicants must be able to operate within the framework of the NSWFA Squad system in conjunction with the NSW Head Coach/Australian National Coach for sabre, and must be able to attend the main NSWFA Squad session for sabre.
