CALL FOR INTEREST: NSW STATE SQUAD CLUB VENUE – SABRE

The New South Wales Fencing Association (NSWFA) calls for expressions of interest from affiliated fencing clubs in metropolitan Sydney to host an auxiliary NSWFA Squad session for Sabre once per week.

OVERVIEW

The host club will provide a venue for the running of an auxiliary NSWFA Squad session in Sabre for two (2) hours per week, at a time and place that suits requirements set by the Assistant National Coach – Sabre, and NSW Head Coach.

CRITERIA

Interested clubs must be affiliated with NSWFA and able to host up to 24 squad fencers during the two-hour session. A minimum of two (2) electronic scoring boxes and reels or equivalent must be available for use during this time, with the boxes calibrated to current FIE requirements for Sabre.

REMUNERATION

To be negotiated with the NSWFA executive.
